The 5th Guru (Arjan) established Amritsar as the capital of the Sikh world and compiled the first book of Sikh scripture the Adi Granth

The 10th Guru, Gobind Singh, turned the Sikhs into a military group of religious believers

After the 10th Guru, Sikhs considered their scriptures as their Gurus
